



**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN
BADMINTON EUROPE CONFEDERATION
AND
CZECH BADMINTON FEDERATION**

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MoU)

PARTIES

- A. **BADMINTON EUROPE CONFEDERATION (“BEC”)** with headquarters in Broendbytoften 14, 2605 Broendby, Denmark. BEC is recognised by Badminton World Federation as the Continental Confederation administering the sport of badminton in Europe.
- B. **CZECH BADMINTON FEDERATION (“CBF”)**, with headquarters in Zátopkova 100/2, 160 17 Prague 6, Czechia. CBF is the National Governing Body for the sport of badminton in Czechia, recognised by the NOC of Czechia.

INTRODUCTION

- C. BEC wishes to strengthen the relationship with CBF via this MoU and provide support in multiple priority areas of CBF.
- D. The parties have identified and agreed on certain areas which include the key areas of development via the 2022 and 2023 BEC Member Surveys.
- E. The MoU is a working document that enables a stronger cooperation between BEC and CBF.

BEC INTENTIONS

- F. BEC shall promote the CBF via a specific area of the BEC website dedicated to CBF.
- G. BEC shall provide technical assistance to CBF as required in particular in the five areas listed in the action plan if applicable.
- H. BEC undertakes to work with CBF in good faith on the development of badminton within the territory of CBF.

CBF INTENTIONS

- I. CBF shall complete the BEC Member Survey on an annual basis.
- J. CBF shall provide BEC with their Strategic Plan at the signing of the MoU and no later than 1 month after the Strategic Plan has been updated.
- K. CBF shall link to the BEC website from the front page of the CBF website.
- L. CBF shall promote the BEC streaming platform and the BEC App with logos and link on the CBF website (graphics will be provided by BEC).

ACTIONS OF THE PARTIES

- M. The parties shall acknowledge and promote the mutual cooperation and set up regular communication with each other regarding the general progress of the action plan.
- N. The parties shall cooperate to improve mutually agreed areas of CBF which are listed hereunder in the action plan.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS


- T. This MoU is not legally binding and does not create any rights or obligations for either of the parties.
