The invitation is based on the following terms:

- The organizer will provide transport for umpires arriving at Naples Airport (IATA abbreviation: NAP).
- All travelling expenses to/from Naples will be on the account of the umpires or their National Association.
- The organizer will pay for umpires' accommodation. All umpires are expected to share rooms with their colleagues.
- The organizer will provide transport between the venue and the hotel. The tournament will be played at the [Palaunisa A Via Salvatore Allende n°1 Baronissi Salerno, Italy](#).
- The host organization shall cover all meal expenses for umpires. Additionally, a daily per diem will be issued for all active duty days.
- All umpires are expected to arrive on Sunday, July 26<sup>th</sup>, in time for the briefing at 20:00. Arrival at Naples airport must therefore no later than 17:00. Departure is scheduled for Saturday, August 1<sup>st</sup>, after the finals, or Sunday, August 2<sup>nd</sup>, should no flights be available on Saturday evening.
